2022 Apologies

Apologies were received from Councillors Mrs J Gantlett and Alan Hill

2023 Public Participation

Mrs Henshaw wished to congratulate Cllr D Grafton for the excellent job he had done cutting back the Rights of Way. She also requested the Parish Council push forward with 'Green Waste' strategy.

Mrs Henshaw informed the Meeting she is on the Committee to look into the reduction in lighting in our Community Area. She reported the Area Board has £5000.00 available for this project

Mr Caswill suggested the Parish Councillors have email addresses on the Cherhill Web Site – this will be set up by Cllr B Seed

Mr Caswill also expressed concern regarding 'noise' in the village of Cherhill from Loud Music, Motor Bikes/Quads and Barking Dogs. Councillors are concerned about this and requested Villagers need to contact Environment Health Direct Line 01249 – 706555 to report any incidents

Mr John Ashcroft reported that the grant for £20,000.00 promised from Wiltshire Council/Playbuilder Scheme could be cut back. An order had been placed for the equipment on 9th July and the announcement was made on 14th July re cutbacks. A decision will be made by the end of August and meanwhile the order has been placed 'on hold'. Cllr S Bodman thanked Mr Ashcroft for all he has done

Mr Colin Kinnerson from Wiltshire Council who was in attendance reported on the administering the 106 Agreement monies. These monies go towards local Public Open Spaces and rules are very stringent on what is allowed and what is not. No money for repairs/Maintenance. Hopefully the money from development at 43 The Street Cherhill will go towards Tommy Croker Playing Field. Mr Kinnerson was also asked to check with regard to Sweets building in Maiden Lane.
