2048 Apologies

2049 Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on Monday 24th May 2010 having been circulated were confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman, proposed by Cllr M Kamkar and seconded by Cllr D Willett

2050 Accounts

Clerks Salary and expenses £162.01– it was proposed by Cllr M Kamkar and seconded by Cllr D Grafton that this account be paid

2051 Planning

To note applications

Councillors discussed the Cricketers Rest application to which there are no objections. Neighbours are concerned this will lead to further applications but this does not effect this application

2052 Presentation of the Accounts

The Clerk presented the Accounts for year ending 31st March 2010. The Balance carried forward is £1790.47 – this compares to previous year of £1629.59. Total receipts were £8943.01 and Payments total £8782.13. Income was high due to transfer of funds from Tommy Croker. Analysis of Variances were presented. The necessary forms for the Audit

Commission were signed by the Chairman and the Clerk. The Accounts will now be passed to Mr D Hubbard for Audit – proposed by Cllr D Grafton and seconded by Cllr D Willett

2053 Transport Group

Cllr S Bodman reported on the last meeting on 25th May. Mr Tatton-Bennett of Community First attended. Approximately 330 Questionnaires were delivered and roughly 1/3 were returned. Unfortunately a large number were not filled in and the relevant questions were not answered. The forms were analysed at the Meeting and there were only 8 people who were unable to get to the Bus Stop. There are a few questionnaires to come back. Cllr D Evans and Mrs A Henshaw volunteered to contact local Groups to enquire if they would have a mini bus available to use. Date for next meeting to be arranged

2054 Rights of Way

Cllr M Kamkar reported on the Meeting held on 27th May with Councillors D Grafton and B Seed. Minutes from the Meeting have been sent to all Councillors. Cllr D Grafton has agreed to do the mowing again this year with an approximate cost of £200.00. Cllr M Kamkar has been in touch with Richard Broadhead Wiltshire Council Rights of Way Manager and Tracy Gieran of Community Payback Scheme. She is in the process of arranging a meeting with the Wardens.

Notice to be put in next Newsletter asking for Walkers to report any problems. It was decided to offer Walkers a coloured map with the relevant numbers on. Cllr D Willett to arrange for the coloured maps to be printed after Cllr M Kamkar has numbered the Rights of Way on the original map. These will be available from Cllrs M Kamkar, D Grafton and the Clerk

2055 Yatesbury Pond

Cllr M Kamkar said she has sent the necessary Application to the Environment Agency and is awaiting permission to proceed with ‘weed control’ suitable for the Pond. She has already obtained quotes for the work

2056 Cherhill and Yatesbury Village Plan

Cllr D Willett reported the final meeting is on 8th June and will be published after the final amendments have been made. There are sufficient funds from the grant to cover the final cost of printing

2057 Correspondence

2058 Quarterly Newsletter

Matters for inclusion were discussed. Cllr S Bodman will report on the Rights of Way, the new School Bus Stop, barking dogs causing problems for neighbours, the Transport Group and the Energy Saving Group.

2059 Cherhill School Bus Stop

Councillors were made aware of the new position at our previous Meeting. It was resolved that the Clerk write to Mr Cook Highways Engineer to agree to this new stop, also to agree the yellow lines in the Bus Stop to say 'No Parking between hours of 8am till 5pm during term time'

2060 Village Matters

Cllr S Bodman requested the Clerk report to Mr Cook re the drain which protrudes in The Street by Westlea Garages which has been reported before to Westlea Housing to no avail

Cllrs all felt the Parish Steward was not doing the jobs that he had been given – Clerk to report to Highways

Cllrs D Willett felt we need to improve our 'Website'. The content needs refreshing and should be accessed more easily. He will approach 'Resolution' a firm doing his work website to ask them if they would be interested in making it more 'user friendly' The Parish Council will consult with Cllr Seed for his advise.

Cllr S Bodman requested the Clerk contact Wiltshire Council Planning Department asking the question 'was planning permission needed to build wall in Conservation Area' (The Old Schoolhouse in Cherhill) also to chase up position on wall in Maiden Lane.

Clerk to write to owner of 2 Olivers Close re bushes over pavement also owners of Mill Cottage where bushes are growing over the Lane

The Clerk reported Mr Spencer will very kindly 'litter pick' in Cherhill and has requested we provide a 'litter picker' Clerk or Chairman to purchase
