#### 2062 Apologies

Apologies were received from Councillor Alan Hill

#### 2063 Public Participation

Mr G Hancock reported that there were still potholes in Back Lane and opposite his house in The Street Yatesbury. He said these were not 'sealed' around the edges when they were done and are now about 4 ins deep again. The verges at the top end of Back Lane had not been cut. Report to Clarence and Clerk will contact Wiltshire Council re Parish Steward doing the grass cutting.

Mrs Henshaw commented on the state of the Pond, especially with all the visitors to the Village Hall. The Parish Council is waiting for a licence that is required from the Environment Agency.

Mrs Henshaw also requested an update of the Rights of Way. She is particularly concerned about 'Cherhill 3'. She informed the Meeting that she has been told at various Meetings she has attended that there is no money available and there is going to be a 40% cut back by Wiltshire Council meaning Parish Councils will have to be more responsible for local issues. Cllr M Kamkar informed the Meetings she has been in touch with the local Wardens who are going to speak to local Farmers and then meet with her.

### 2067 Community Bus Update

Cllr S Bodman reported that the outcome of the last meeting showed the responses were not good and only 8 Villagers had restricted mobility. This needs to be addressed first. ### 2069 Cherhill Website

This will be mentioned in the next Newsletter due in July. After discussion Cllr B Seed agreed to continue to run this but pointed out he requires more information. Clerk to liaise with Cllr B Seed – Payment of £30.00 per month to be paid 6 monthly –proposed by Cllr M Kamkar and seconded by Cllr D Grafton

### 2070 Cherhill and Yatesbury Parish Plan

Cllr D Willett reported on this and it has been completed and adopted. Cllr D Willett had obtained quotes and it was decided to order 50 copies at a cost of £347.00. These will be A4 size and bound. 4 'high gloss' copies were also ordered at a cost of £137.00 Proposed by Cllr S Bodman and seconded by Cllr M Kamkar that these be ordered.

It was proposed we write a letter regarding the pathway from Hayle Farm to the Village to have it changed to shared pathway for walkers and cyclists. Cllr D Willett reported on the amount of rubble being dumped on the Right of Way leading from the A4 to the Barn (He had taken photographs) Clerk to contact R Broadhead Rights of Way Manager

Cllr B Seed requested that the new bus stop in Middle Lane (with yellow lines) be amended to 8am – 4pm Clerk to contact M Cook (term time only?)
