2797 Public Participation

Mr Watkins reported that the quality of work done to potholes in Yatesbury is dreadful and already breaking up – Clerk to report to T Ruse. He reported that a villager had fallen over one by the bus stop and broken her arm. He also reported he understood that fibre optic cables for Broadband is coming as far as the Hangars for 01249 exchange.

Concern was expressed that Will Woodland have not removed the deer fencing even though the trees are big now. Rights of Way have not been re-opened. Clerk to invite Oliver Mead to next Meeting.

Mr Chivers expressed concern about Barrow Way. Cllr B Seed reported that road chippings have been put at the far end ready for distribution.

Mrs Mburu and another Parent of Cherhill School came to express concern regarding the speed of traffic along Middle Lane and also Marsh Lane. Could a safety 'drop off zone' be implemented – look in to possible solution. Mr Cavanagh stated a Traffic Management needed to be agreed. Cllr D Grafton informed the meeting that unfortunately the school have not supported the Parish Council in

the past when offers were made to make more parking available on school premises. Could flashing signs be installed, also 10mph speed limit. – November Agenda item.

A Resident in Pottows Field had requested that the Council could put in some form of Lighting in the Area where mostly senior Villagers live. The Clerk reported she had contacted Wiltshire Council for a quote. Unfortunately this was beyond our budget and agreed to pursue the possibility of the Residents having PIR Lighting - November Agenda

Cllr D Evans is concerned that nothing has been done to the bridge railings in Mill Lane. This has been reported to both Martin Cook and Tracy Ruse by the Clerk – Clerk to pursue

Cllr S Orton reported she had a meeting with Judy Edwards of Calne Town Council regarding Tourism in Calne and surrounding Villages. Cllr S Orton is representing the Parish Council on this Group

Cllr B Seed reported that although work had been done at the Bus Stop opposite it still needed to be cleaned up – Clerk to report to Tracy Ruse

Cllr S Tomlinson is concerned about the White Horse (which sadly is grey just now) A Major refurbishment will be carried out in May 2015. Cllr D Grafton reported that unfortunately the difficulty getting the right chalk
