Cllr M Purslow reported that the white lines Road Markings on the A4 has not been done. Clerk to contact Martin Cook and also thanks him for the good job done on The Street Yatesbury

Clerk to contact Greensquare asking for a copy of their policy for arranging occupants for the 4 new houses in The Street which we would have liked to be informed of.

Cllr B Seed reported that the school have arranged for a 'drop off zone' outside the main gates and are keen to get access (accompanied by staff) up to the A4.

Clerk to speak to Rob Pickford regarding any right of way across Yatesbury Field. This is currently a Conservation Area

Cllr D Grafton reported we need more offers of help when the White Horse is re charked in May 2015. It will need scouring first. Clerk to try and contact Andy Stagg regarding the Scouts helping, also Mrs Margaret Smith re Cubs and Beavers. Clerk to contact Rob Pickford for dates for Meeting but we need to find out if the Scouts are available first

Clerk to contact Keith Steggall regarding fencing which is broken around the White Horse – charge Parish Council if necessary

Cllr S Tomlinson reported on the amount of litter at Yatesbury end of Jugglers Lane. He hoped this could be dealt with by the Countryside Access Volunteers

Neighbourhood Plan

This will be reviewed every 6 months. Check and monitor Calne and Compton Bassett Plans

Cllr D Grafton reported he had looked at very heavy duty plastic seats which cost £400.00 each. Clerk to contact Jane Vaughan re possibility of funding from Area Board

Cllr M Wilkins requested the Clerk to contact Highways to enquire if there is any possibility of re surfacing Nolands Road- very bad/deep potholes

Cllr M Purslow reported there had been a meeting with regard to Broadband at Yatesbury which was attended y Richard Watkins and Mark Wilkins of Le Roc. They are meeting with B T and Mr Khanfer will attend this as well – hopefully end of January

Cllr D Grafton reported he is in the process of putting together a Planning Application for cutting back trees around the Playing Field.. Nearby property owners have been consulted and agree to the proposals
