3163 Report from Cllr S Tomlinson regarding Parish Steward Scheme

Cllr S Tomlinson had attended the meeting arranged by Wiltshire Council at the Council Offices Chippenham to organize the commencement of the Parish Steward Scheme. Ringway Parkman were represented. There will be 20 Parish Stewards in the County. Ringway are waiting to appoint an area Engineer to cover the County areas. There is still some uncertainty about what the Parish Stewards will do but it is likely to concentrate on road side maintenance, strimming clearing invasive weeds, etc. The new scheme will be operational by October. Parish Councils will highlight jobs that need doing (Clerk to gather information and report). The job schedule has not yet been published but we expect to get a visit once a month. The work schedule will be published in 4 month blocks with no parish work scheduled for May (to allow for dealing with Ragwort) and none for August (to allow for holidays and training). Our list of jobs should be sent in by end of July.
