### 3201 Apologies

### 3202 Declaration of Interest

### 3203 Public Participation

Mr J Ashcroft expressed concern regarding the number of 20mph signs that are going to be painted on all our Roads – this a rural village in AONB and Conservation Area. Clerk to contact Philip Rushmere to discuss the matter. Cllr A Hill had advised this is due to legislation regarding 20mph zones. Unfortunately the Parish Council had not received prior notice or a plan. Wiltshire Council were responsible for this error (Person dealing with it away on Maternity Leave)

Mr and Mrs Ashcroft raised concerns regarding the discussions at previous council meetings about arrangements at the Tommy Croker Playing Field . It was suggested that the Council had made a decision to purchase a container for use at the field, The container is available if required but has not as yet been purchased by the council.

At present the mower is with John and he is able to keep it through the winter. It was also identified that work done on the South Boundary hedge by David Grafton had been invoiced to and paid by the Parish Council in April. This boundary is however owned by Mr and Mrs Jeary. David Grafton understood that the maintenance was the responsibility of the Playing Field ,it would

appear this is not the case and the cost has been reimbursed in full by the owners . David Grafton apologised for the confusion

It was agreed that the Playing field Committee will in future manage the running of the area and update the Parish Council when required .A meeting to elect a committee is planned for November 7th 8pm. at 5 Olivers Close

The Clerk thanked John for his work at the Playing Field

It was also of concern that minor work carried out for the council by the Chairman does not always go through a full tender process. David Grafton will trim the hedge at the Bus Shelter for this Autumn at cost arrangements for any future work within the parish will be looked at as an agenda item at the next meeting .

Cllr D Grafton reported the following for Mrs Henshaw who was unable to attend this meeting. The bridleway inspected by David Grafton & Mrs Henshaw is becoming blocked by encroaching hedge growth leading to Compton Basset. Cllr Mike Wilkins has some details of ownership .

Mrs Henshaw has also had some email contact with Richard Broadhead regarding use of the Bridleway to West Nolands from Jugglers Lane
