Vacancy for Cherhill Parish Councillor

The Parish Council election in May elected four Councillors leaving one councillor position eligible for co-option by the council. The Parish Council want to fill the vacancy of one additional councillor for the Cherhill ward as soon as possible

New defibrillators for Cherhill and Yatesbury - £1938 donated

The Parish Council secured a grant from Calne Area Board of 50% the cost of two additional defibrillators to provide better emergency coverage in both Cherhill and Yatesbury. One will be installed outside Cherhill School in Middle Lane and the other will be in the centre of Yatesbury. This opportunity came too late to be included in the budgeting for this financial year so funds were needed to cover the remaining cost.

Donations from Cherhill and Yatesbury have totalled £1938.

Hills change plans for the future

Hills sent this statement for this newsletter:

"Hills has started a process of consultation with local stakeholders and community representatives about a package of proposals which it believes will bring about some significant improvements to the traffic and air quality issues in Calne.

The proposals involve some key planning applications which, if successful, would see the construction of an internal link road between the Lower Compton site and the former Aggregate Industries land to the west. The link road would split the site traffic between the two entrances and would prevent HGVs using the site travelling along the A4 through Calne".

Mobile Library

The Mobile Library visits Yatesbury and Cherhill every four weeks. Dates are Mondays this year are October 2nd, November 27th.and December 18th. and January 22nd 2018 at The Lymers, Yatesbury from 11.45 to 12.05, Cherhill Church from 12.15 to 12.35 and Oliver's Hill, Cherhill from 12.40 to 1.00. A wide range of books is available and the friendly Mobile Library is wheelchair accessible.

The mobile library service is currently carrying a consultation about reducing the service in certain areas. However, the service provided in Cherhill and Yatesbury is not included and the service continues as at present.

Cherhill informal one-way system

Cherhill School operates a voluntary one-way system to reduce congestion for children in Middle Lane coming from the A4 and leaving via Oliver's Hill around 8:30 a.m. and at 2:45 p.m.. White lines have been painted around the corners of Middle Lane and Oliver's Hill to show where parking might cause an obstruction.
