## Cherhill informal one-way system

Cherhill School operate a voluntary one-way system for parents who drop off and pick up pupils, entering Middle Lane from the A4 and exiting via Oliver's Hill. Parents using Middle Lane dropping or collecting schoolchildren around 08:30 and around 2:45 is requested to follow this traffic flow system to reduce congestion. White lines have been painted around the corners of Middle Lane and Oliver's Hill to give guidance to where parking would cause an obstruction. The Black Horse car park can be used for short-term temporary parking.
