3260 Re Chalking White Horse

It has been agreed with the Local Scout Movement that the horse is done on 23rd April which is Saint George's Day and celebrates 100 years of scouting. Rob Pickford is ordering chalk and the Scouts and Cub Scouts will bag up the chalk at end of March before Easter Holidays.

3263 Update on Defibrillators

The grant for 2 defibrillators has been approved by the Calne Area Board on a 'match funding' basis with the Parish Council.

Sites for these was discussed and Cllr D Evans reported the Black Horse had agreed to have one outside the pub. It was suggested that perhaps outside the school gates would be more central – Clerk to write to school and advise Cllr B Seed (Chairman of Govenors) Hopefully we will be able to place the other one at the Lymers in Yatesbury in the old phone box (subject to permission with BT)

Cllr S Orton reminded Councillors that John Skinner is attending the next meeting on 5th April to give an update on the Great West Way

Clr M Purslow reported that the Street in Yatesbury continues to flood when it rains heavily – Matt Perrott has been contacted and has promised to look in to the problem

There is also a large pothole opposite the Bee Complex – Cllr M Purslow to report

Cllr S Tomlinson will be attending the next CATG Meeting on 14th March. He will report signage is required in Olivers Hill regarding the numbering.

Signs for Yatesbury will be left until the next financial year

The verges and large potholes where buses over-run in Marsh Lane need attention – Clerk to contact Matt Perrott of Wiltshire Council.

Cllr B Seed to approach Cherhill School regarding installation of Cherhill defibrillator. This would have to be outside school gates
