SHOW RULES - CHERHILL 2018

- 1 Eligibility for Entry: Cherhill Residents, Members of Cherhill Gardening Club, and Members of Cherhill WI.
- 2 All Entries: must be in writing to the Entries' Secretary (form enclosed) not later than 10 p.m. on Wednesday 22nd August 2018
- 3 Use a **separate entry form** for each person plain paper copies are acceptable.
- 4 Number of entries per class: Only one entry per person per class is permitted.
- **5 Exhibits to be staged** in the Village Hall on Show Day between 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.
- 6 Late Entries are not permitted.
- 7 All exhibitors must leave the hall by 11 a.m. to allow judging to commence.
- **8** Any item previously entered in a Cherhill Show will not be accepted.
- **9 All** fruit, flowers & vegetables must be from the **exhibitor's own garden or allotment** with the exception of Flower Arranging Classes 44-47.
- 10 A Novice in classes 46-47 is deemed to be someone who has never won a first prize for a flower arranging exhibit in any of the previous Cherhill Shows.
- **11 Judges' decisions are final.** Prizes can be withheld, or an extra prize awarded in close competition. Any exhibitor may lodge a protest upon payment of £1 to the Show Sec. which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
- **12 Exhibits may not be removed** until after the prize giving & raffle.
- 13 Any infringement of the above Rules will render the exhibitor liable to disqualification and from taking a prize. The Show Committee reserves the right to return any entry and to resolve any question not covered by these Rules. They will take all due care of exhibits staged, but will not be liable for any loss or damage.

N.B. <u>JUNIORS – aged 16 and under</u> - Juniors are most welcome to enter any class in the show. Please enter his/her age on the entry form - these entries may be judged separately.
